Code of Conduct – Students’ Council Elections, 2025

Government Model College, Balipara

The following Code of Conduct shall be observed by all candidates and their supporters to ensure free, fair, and disciplined elections at Government Model College, Balipara.

General Rules

- All campaigning must be peaceful and shall not disturb regular classes or academic activities.
- Candidates must maintain dignity, discipline, and respect towards opponents.
- Only handmade posters are permitted. Posters shall be displayed only in areas designated by the Election Officer.
- The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate is ₹5000. A statement of accounts must be submitted within two weeks of the election results.

Prohibitions

- No printed posters, banners, pamphlets, or use of loudspeakers, vehicles, or animals.
- No involvement of outsiders, political parties, or external agencies in the election process.
- No appeals for votes on the basis of caste, community, religion, or language.
- No campaigning shall take place within 100 meters of polling stations.
- No bribery, intimidation, threats, or personal attacks against other candidates.

Polling Day Rules

- Only voters and authorised polling officials are permitted inside polling booths.
- No campaign material, posters, or propaganda shall be displayed near the polling area.
- Candidates must ensure orderly conduct and respect the secrecy of the ballot.

Post-Election Responsibilities

- All campaign material must be removed within 48 hours after polling.
- Candidates are responsible for ensuring the cleanliness of areas where campaign activities took place.

Disciplinary Action

- Any violation of the Code of Conduct may lead to the disqualification of the candidate.
- The decision of the Returning Officer shall be final, subject to appeal before the principal.
